However, the current scenario vis-à-vis Certification and Testing of Telecom equipment system is rather laggard and there is a need to catch with testing & certification framework, Interoperability Testing, skills and Testing Infrastructure.</p> <p>The recent Gazette Notification on Testing and Certification of Telegraph dated 5th September, 2017 issued by Department of Telecommunications has made it mandatory that all telecom equipment shall have to undergo prior mandatory testing and certification in respect of parameters as determined by the telegraph authority from time to time and must be Certified and Tested by the telegraph authority or any other agency designated by the telegraph authority. Although this measure shall ensure India's preparedness against security testing but without having a proper testing framework, skills and Testing Infrastructure, and especially when OEMs are already carrying our rigorous testing in their lab, this step would not only be fruitful but unnecessary. These equipment's are developed based on various international standards and do undergo rigorous testing and certification regime at international labs for necessary Safety and Security features. Hence, we strongly believe that this measure will only add one more layer of regulation to the struggling telecom industry in India, add up more cost unnecessarily, , go against the spirit of Ease of Doing Business and have greater impact on the global supply chain cycle.</p>	Email Query	Closed
